

Pastor Larry Martin has taken two trips to India to witness the growth of churches in several villages around the Kalwakurthy region. Discovery Community Church now sponsors the ongoing ministry of four indigenous Church Extension Workers in India.

Through the MB Mission of the Mennonite Brethren Church, a campaign called Disciple Making International has been planned in order to partner with these workers and help them witness to their neighbours in the Kollapur region.

The team in India includes Reverend Gundepogu Ross, Bashar, Masters, Elisha, another Elisha, and a number of translators. Joining them from Campbell River will be Pastor Larry Martin, Ron Quinton, Ray Boyd, Jennifer Falstrem, Don and Denise Voysey, Michelle Diemer, Jocelyn Diemer, and Coleen Ray. This year, Nathan Kinsey from Quadra Island will also join the Canadian team.

For two weeks, there will be opportunity to minister alongside national believers by visiting local churches and home meetings, sharing messages and testimonies with the help of the local partners, and explaining God's plan of salvation. There will also be opportunity to return for a follow-up lesson with those who respond to the gospel in a positive way.
