Dear pastors and church chairs,

Greetings in Christ! May God bless you, and may this New Year be one of His blessings and fruitfulness.

Our annual *LPD Conference* is coming up on *March 4, 5 at White Rock Community Church,* 15280 Pacific Avenue in White Rock. - How do we become better listeners to others and to the voice of the Holy Spirit?

Coaching is defined as, "... an on-going intentional conversation that empowers a person or group to fully live out God's calling." (Keith E. Webb, founder of COACH). The coach's role is not to have all the answers, but to encourage the coachee to reflect, and to direct them to the Holy Spirit, our ultimate counsellor, and to growth in the Body of Christ. As Webb writes, "The key to effective coaching is for the coachee and coach to understand what God is doing and join in His work."

As your Lower Pacific District, and in cooperation with the EFCC LeadBeyond initiative, we would like to provide equipping for you to become a better encouragement to others in their growth and Christian walk. As we believe that this COACH training is important for you and for our churches, we are including this training and participant workbook with your conference registration at no extra charge.
